

IEN Bridging/RN Re-Entry Scholarship

One scholarship is awarded annually to an individual who has completed the IEN Bridging Program through the Centre for Nursing Studies.

One scholarship is awarded annually to an individual who has completed the RN Re-Entry Program offered through the Centre for Nursing Studies.

The reference should be completed by a nursing faculty member or clinical instructor from the relevant program (IEN Bridging or Re-Entry). The same form is used to provide a reference for both scholarships.

You will be required to provide the following information on your reference:

A. Applicant Information

- Name
- CRNNL Registration Number (***REQUIRED** – to be provided by the applicant)
- E-Mail (***REQUIRED** – to be provided by the applicant)
- How you've known the applicant
- How long you've known the applicant

B. Your Information

- Your contact information (employer, phone, email etc.)

C. Applicant Characteristics and Abilities

- You must rank the applicant on the following characteristics and abilities:
 - academic ability
 - communication (verbal and/or written)
 - motivation and initiative (e.g., participation in class/discussion)
 - actual/potential contribution to nursing
 - performance in nursing practice

D. Reference Statement

- Provide a brief statement about the applicant's strengths and potential for making a significant contribution to the nursing profession (maximum **500** words).
